Polling was conducted online from February 6-8, 2024. Using Dynamic Online Sampling to attain a representative sample, Change Research polled 1,534 registered voters in the United States. Post-stratification was performed on age, gender, race/ethnicity, education, region, CDC urbanicity, and 2020 presidential vote.
