
Change Research, a national research firm that has conducted more than 3,000 polls of over 3 million people since 2017, conducted a survey in Oklahoma from March 15-18, 2024.¹

Oklahoma voters intensely disapprove of Ryan Walters

Oklahoma's Superintendent of Public Instruction Ryan Walters, who is under fire for his anti-LGBTQ+ rhetoric leading up to and following Nex Benedict's death, is significantly underperforming in the eyes of Oklahoma voters after being elected to the position less than 18 months ago. A majority (55%) of voters disapprove of the job he is doing as Superintendent, including 42% who *strongly* disapprove, while just 28% approve. Parents and guardians of students enrolled in Oklahoma's K-12 public schools are especially disapproving.

Walters Job Approval Significantly Underwater CHANGE RESEARCH


Do you approve or disapprove of the job Ryan Walters is doing as Oklahoma's Superintendent of Public Instruction?



Even self-identified Republican voters hold mixed views of the Superintendent. The proportion of Republicans who hold a favorable opinion of him (33%) outweighs the proportion who hold an unfavorable opinion (25%) by just 8 points. These same voters hold an intensely positive view of Donald Trump (83% favorable, including 59% *very* favorable, and just 12% unfavorable).

Nearly 2 in 3 Oklahoma voters want the state legislature to impeach or investigate Walters

Half (52%) of Oklahoma voters say that the state legislature should impeach Superintendent Ryan Walters, and another 11% want the legislature to investigate and consider whether impeachment is warranted. Just 26% say that Walters should not be investigated or impeached.

Voters' concerns about Walters span a variety of issues, from promoting a culture of dangerous intolerance to his failure to distribute millions of dollars to schools

Oklahoma voters disagree with Superintendent Walters on a variety of issues, and they don't just disagree with his positions and actions since taking office; they actively like him less as a result.

Voters are especially concerned that Walters failed to distribute millions of dollars in funding to Oklahoma schools, and that he appointed Chaya Raichik, a notably unqualified candidate, to Oklahoma's state library panel.


Oklahomans believe that Ryan Walters is a poor role model for students

61% believe Ryan Walters is not a good role model for Oklahoma's students. A majority (55%) of parents and guardians of K-12 students in Oklahoma's public schools say Walters is *definitely* not a good role model for their children.
